Dove House Children's Advocacy Center embraces a coordinated, comprehensive and systematic approach, which is child-focused, family-friendly, community-oriented and facility-based. We are a resource designed to enhance the coordination among existing community agencies involved in the investigation and intervention process, while keeping the well being of the child as our central focus. We exist in order to:

- Provide a child-friendly facility where investigation and intervention activities take place so that further trauma to child victims and non-offending family members is minimized;
- Facilitate investigations with all involved community professionals from initial case assessment to final disposition, with the goal of enhancing the process for optimal case resolution.
- Promote therapeutic interventions for child victims and their families in order to maximize their progress towards healing;
- Provide the child and non-offending family members with support and consistency in case activities,
 including the criminal prosecution process and overall case follow-up communications;
- Mobilize and train community agencies and professionals to better serve child victims of sexual assault;
- Maintain a central repository for all data concerning child sexual abuse in Iredell and Alexander Counties through maintenance of a child-focused data tracking system
- Prior to Dove House's existence, approximately 20% of offenders were convicted. Since Dove House's inception, the conviction rate has risen to 86%.

Blue Oval Classic Vendor Information

The Blue Oval Classic reserves space for a variety of vendors on the show grounds. This includes vendors for food, auto-related items, and non-auto-related items.

In order to make the day worthwhile, the FOAC only allows a limited number of food vendors at the event. Food is a very important part of the day for our guests. If a food vendor doubts their ability to attend the event, they should not request a space.

Most vendor areas are on grassy areas. A limited number of blacktop locations are available for vendors with trailers, or other considerations.

All vendors must work with an FOAC representative to reserve a space. The associated fee or deposit must be paid in advance.

Non-food vendors will be charged a fee of \$25 for a 10' x 10' space. Additional fees will be negotiated for larger spaces.

Food vendors will be charged 10% of their gross receipts taken in at the event. To reserve a space, food vendors are to pay a deposit of \$100 prior to the event. Within 15 days after the event, the vendor must contact their FOAC representative, to let the FOAC know the amount of the vendor's gross receipts. The total fee will be calculated at that time. If the vendor's gross receipts exceed \$1,000, the deposit will be applied towards the total fee, and the unpaid balance will be due within 30 days of the event. If the vendor's gross receipts are less than \$1,000, the difference between the \$100 deposit, and the total fee due, will be refunded to the vendor within 30 days of the event. If the vendor does not attend the event, their deposit will not be refunded.

As the show grounds fill up fast with lots of show cars moving about, those vendors who reserve a booth space must be on the grounds and unloaded no later than 8:00AM. If you are bringing a trailer, it is suggested that you are in place even earlier. No hookups for electricity or water are provided. Vendors are required to provide their own tables and chairs. Canopies can only be used on grassy areas, and must be anchored. Please work with your FOAC representative, in advance, to discuss your requirements.

The Blue Oval Classic is a "rain or shine" event.
